The Endless Pool is a modular system that fits just about anywhere and can be assembled ready to swim in a few days by two handy people. Thousands of our customers have taken this on as a DIY project and we have developed a comprehensive set of materials including a step-by-step installation DVD to support them. In addition, we have an excellent Customer Service Department that is available 7 days a week to answer questions. Those who choose to self-install can save money.

If You Need Help

For those not interested in installing the Endless Pool themselves, we have a nationwide network of independent Factory Trained Installers (FTI's) who have been recommended by customers and have received training at our facility in Pennsylvania. They are local contractors in your area who carry insurance. If you have a contractor performing other work for you related to your Endless Pool project, our FTI's can perform the pool installation working directly for your contractor. Keep in mind, however, that our FTI's are also often qualified to perform additional tasks common to a pool installation. These specialties may include excavation, concrete and tile work, carpentry, plumbing, and electrical work.

These independent FTI's have agreed to offer a comprehensive installation service at a guaranteed price to Endless Pool customers who have an "appropriate site". This service is covered under a contract that you will have directly with the FTI. The precise terms of that offer are described in the following pages.

SITE PREPARATION

Is Your Site Ready?

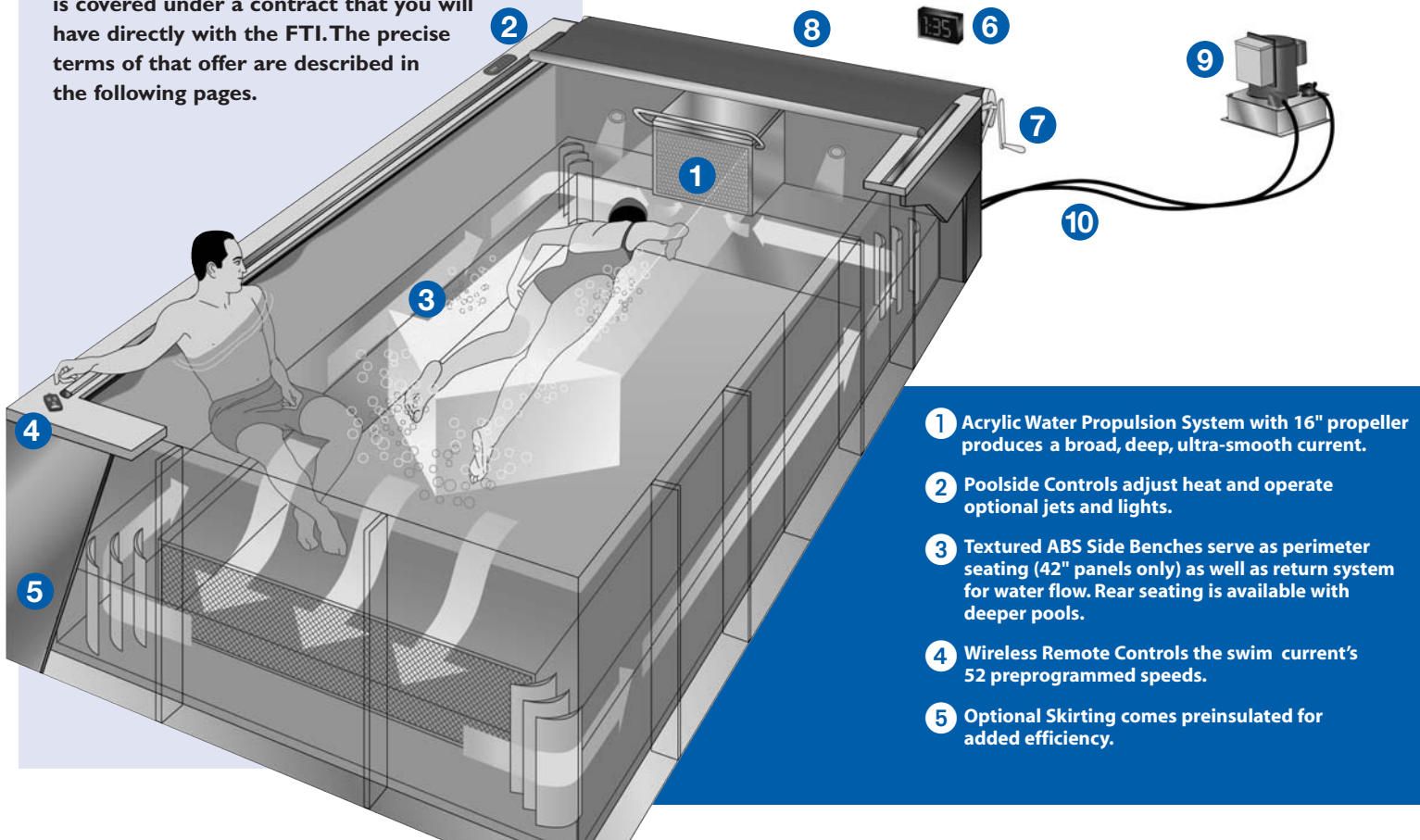
An "appropriate site" is a nearly level concrete surface two feet wider and three feet longer than the inside dimensions of the Endless Pool you select. If your proposed site is slightly smaller in one or both dimensions than the requirements listed above, exceptions can be made after conferring with your Endless Pool Design representative and confirming with your FTI.

Our optional Floor Leveling System is designed to accommodate irregular floors up to 2" out of level. Please remember that custom deeper wells, or any floor preparation beyond our leveling system is outside the scope of the installation program. Your FTI may be able to perform site preparation under a separate contract. Consult with your FTI or an appropriate contractor if you are considering this type of work.

The Endless Pool is typically delivered by Allied Van Lines to your driveway. They have an uncrating service for \$50 that moves everything indoors to the site of your installation. This is usually a very good deal that is part of the white glove Allied service. If you don't use this service the FTI may charge for moving the 2,000 plus pounds of equipment to the pool site.

Given the appropriate site described above, the FTI will:

- assemble the Endless Pool
- plumb the Water Quality System on the front panel
- install any options that you purchase from Endless Pools, Inc.
- place the Hydraulic Power Unit at a location of your choosing
- run two hydraulic lines of specified length, a flexible conduit carrying 4 wires, and a bonding wire all supplied by Endless Pools, Inc.
- supervise electric hook-up
- fill the pool, run all systems, and provide one hour of training



- 1 Acrylic Water Propulsion System with 16" propeller produces a broad, deep, ultra-smooth current.
- 2 Poolside Controls adjust heat and operate optional jets and lights.
- 3 Textured ABS Side Benches serve as perimeter seating (42" panels only) as well as return system for water flow. Rear seating is available with deeper pools.
- 4 Wireless Remote Controls the swim current's 52 preprogrammed speeds.
- 5 Optional Skirting comes preinsulated for added efficiency.

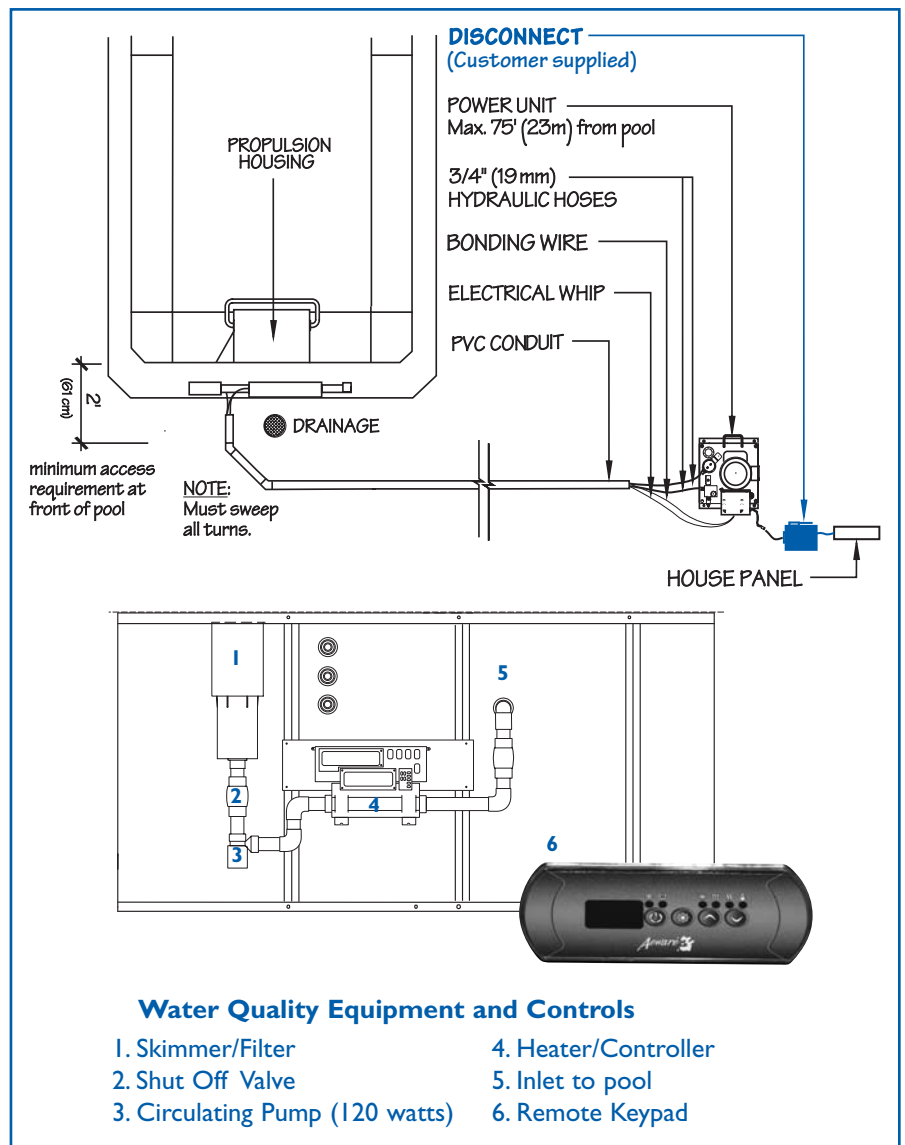
ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS

Powering Your Pool

In addition to providing a suitable site you must have your electrician bring a 30 amp, 220 volt GFCI protected shutoff to wherever you plan to locate the Hydraulic Power Unit. This is the same power requirement as for an electric clothes dryer. If your house electric panel is near the pool site, the Power Unit can be placed next to the house panel minimizing the work of your electrician. If you want to put the Power Unit in a closet near the pool, your electrician will have to bring a shutoff to that closet. The Power Unit is supplied with a 6' cord or "whip" which connects to the shutoff.

Endless Pools, Inc., provides two hydraulic lines, bonding wire, and flexible conduit of a pre-determined length. These connect between the Power Unit and the front panel of the pool where the Water Quality System is installed under a protective shroud behind whatever skirting you select. The path that these lines take is your responsibility. If a chase, or 4" conduit is desired, or significant work must be undertaken to run these lines, that work is outside the scope of the guaranteed installation price and can be included in a separate contract with your FTI.

Connecting the 6' cord to the shutoff and connecting either end of the 4 wire conduit to the Water Quality Controller poolside and the Power Unit can be performed by a licensed electrician or the homeowner. The FTI can instruct you or your electrician concerning this 20 minute task and can generally hook up the system for testing purposes but their license often requires them to leave the system disconnected when they leave your home.



Installing Your Options

Your FTI can install any of the options available from Endless Pools, Inc. except Gas Heaters. This only applies, however, to options supplied with the pool and where other work isn't required to complete the installation of the option. A custom tile coping, for example, means that the Retractable Security Cover cannot be installed until the coping is complete. Your FTI can usually accommodate but timing, scheduling and potential extra costs may be involved. Using our Synthetic Coping System allows your FTI to install a Retractable Security Cover at the same time.

Our Wood or Synthetic Skirting Systems allow you to finish off the outside of your Endless Pool while having it insulated at the same time. If you choose other skirting options, consider how you will insulate the pool to save energy. Your FTI or your design representative will have suggestions. A well insulated Endless Pool is well worth the effort in energy savings over the many years that you will enjoy your pool.

Other Considerations

Permitting is not included in the guaranteed installation price and is your responsibility. By not anchoring the Endless Pool to the ground and using our optional Floor Leveling and Tension Strap System the Endless Pool may be considered a "transportable spa" rather than a permanent pool. This distinction may have favorable permit ramifications. Your local permit official, however, is the ultimate arbiter on permit requirements. Discuss with your FTI your permit status. Typically your electrician can pull a permit for a "transportable spa" requiring a 30 amp, 220 volt service.

Travel is typically included in this agreement with some exceptions. In certain metropolitan areas or where the FTI is some distance away, additional charges may apply. Be sure to discuss this before signing your contract with the FTI.

- 6 Optional Digital Swim Pace Display with 7" high-visibility, LED display allows you to see your swim pace.
- 7 Optional Manual or Automatic Retractable Security Covers lock in heat and lock out dirt and debris.
- 8 Computerized Water Quality System mounted on the front panel under the cover.
- 9 5 hp Hydraulic Motor powers the propulsion system creating a current wider than your body and deeper than your stroke.
- 10 Two Hydraulic Lines, Bonding Wire, Flexible Conduit with Four #10 Wires supplied by Endless Pools, Inc. to length specified.

CONTROLLING COSTS

The cost of installing an Endless Pool® varies considerably depending on the type of installation and the construction around the pool. The cost of constructing the space surrounding the pool (particularly new construction) and finishing details will have a significant impact on the total project cost. To minimize your overall project costs, please consider:

- Select an existing site and be swimming in days.**
The Endless Pool is designed for easy installation in an existing room. Constructing a new space will typically result in additional expense.
- Aboveground installations – even with deeper pools.**
The Endless Pool is free standing, perfect for an above-ground installation. Aboveground installations are usually less expensive than partially or completely in-ground installations. Decking up around a finished pool makes it appear built in. Decking is typically less expensive than sinking a pool into the ground.
- Use standard finishes.**
Endless Pools can provide finished Synthetic Coping and Skirting. These standard finishes allow our expert installers to have your pool completely finished before they leave – the only decision you need to make is what bathing suit to wear.
- Our Pools are manufactured to operate efficiently.**
The Endless Pool Skirting Systems come complete with an R11 insulation system and a floating thermal cover to reduce heat loss and control humidity. Our super efficient circulating pump uses less energy to run than a 120 watt bulb.
